**Gift Development** is about an ongoing commitment to improving the way we play, sing, or run the technical aspects of the worship services. This involves things such as:

- ♦ practicing at home and at team practices to improve your musicianship and/or vocal competency
- ♦ learning how to skilfully operate the sound and data equipment
- ♦ being organised with your personal music files
- ♦ caring for your instruments
- ♦ having a working knowledge of the sound equipment needed for your area
- ♦ being creative and courageous in trying new things to improve our worship ministry





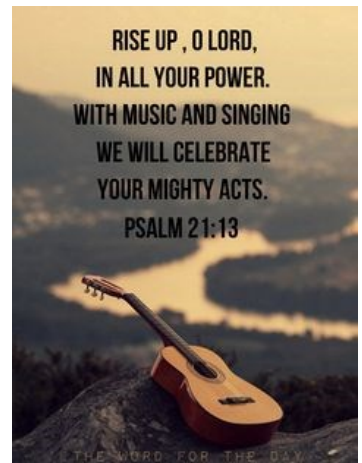
