### CHOOSING "REAL LIFE" - Saying "Yes" to God

The Bible says that God created us and loves us, and invites us into a life-changing relationship with Him. This new life with God empowers us with hope, peace, joy and strength in the midst of a broken and hurting world. If you want to experience this "Real Life" you need to respond to God's invitation sincerely as follows:

Admit you're not perfect. That shouldn't be too hard, right? If we're really honest with ourselves, we know we've done things that weren't up to God's perfect standards. The Bible calls this sin, and sin damages us, our relationship with God, and with other people. The first step towards a relationship with God is to admit we're sinners (we call this "confessing our sins") and ask for His forgiveness.<sup>1</sup>

Believe in Jesus Christ. Jesus is so much more than a good teacher, wise prophet, or religious guru - He's 100% God - and believing in Him is the only way to have our sins forgiven and come into relationship with God. To believe in Jesus is to believe he's fully God and that he entered our world and lived a perfect life (that we couldn't); died on a cross to pay for our sin (to take our penalty), rose again from the dead (to prove his identity, power and authority), rules from Heaven; and will one day return to judge and rule the world.<sup>2</sup>

Commit to following Jesus as Lord & King. Jesus is described in the Bible as the most powerful authority in existence. Saying "Yes" to God means taking a 180° direction change (we call this "repentance") and living under the leadership of Jesus. This takes courage and faith but we can't experience "real life" until we let go of control, and allow Jesus the Christ to be the Lord & King of our lives.<sup>3</sup>

If you're ready to say "Yes" to God and begin the Christian journey there's a simple prayer you can say and God will respond to the truth of your heart and give you a new life in Jesus Christ. If you need help, or have questions, come to the front after the service and there'll be people ready to talk and pray with you.


Father God, I thank you that you created me in your image for relationship with you and that you love me unconditionally. I admit today that I'm a sinner and I ask for your forgiveness. I believe in Jesus Christ as my Saviour and King and I welcome you into my life today. Fill me with your Holy Spirit and help me to live a life that pleases and honours you for Your glory. Amen.

If you've prayed this prayer with sincerity you're now a Christian, born again into the family of God! The Bible says your decision to become a Christian has caused the angels in heaven to celebrate!<sup>4</sup>

It's now important to stay connected with other Christians who will help you grow in this new relationship with God and we'd love you to be part of our family here at BBCC.

If you choose to say "no" to God today, you need to seriously consider the consequences. Rejecting God's offer of relationship means you're rejecting the Creator and Sustainer of life. The Bible says that has terrible consequences for this life, and the life to come. While the choice will always be yours, we hope and pray you'll reconsider God's offer of real life and we're always available to talk more about this.
