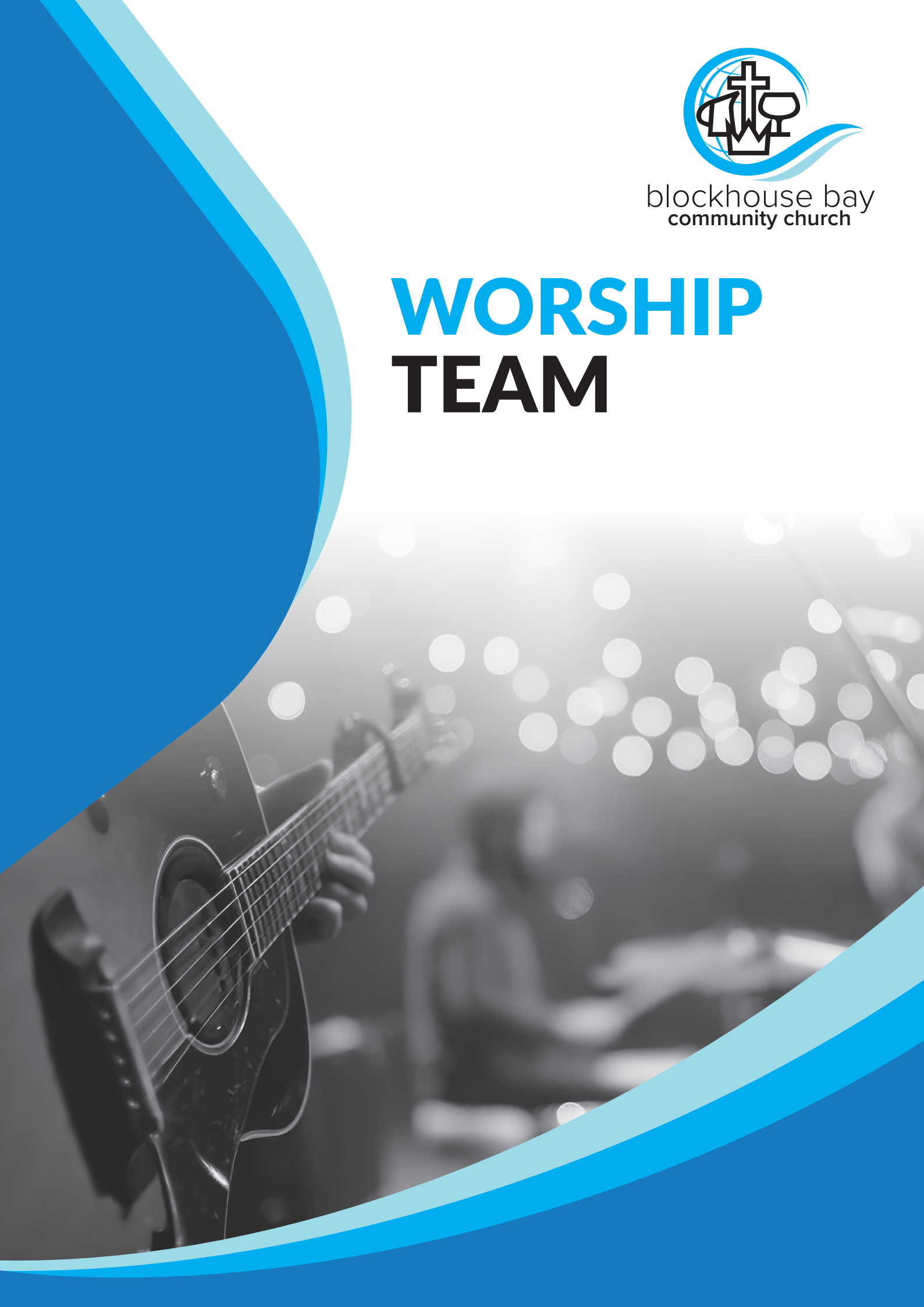

**Our Worship Team** is made up of singers, musicians, data, livestream, and sound techs and we're always looking for new people to join the team.

**We're committed to leading our church family into meaningful expressions of worship which glorify God and bring strength and encouragement to our people.**

The Worship Team supports the ministry of the entire service and therefore works with the Pastors to support the direction and theme of each service.

## **GIVING OUR BEST**

We want to honour God by giving Him our 'Highest Praise". This involves **giving God the very best of our musical, technical, and creative gifts** and being **faithful, obedient, followers of Jesus**. To do this, we focus on two main areas – **Gift Development & Spiritual Growth**.

### **Gift Development**

**Gift Development** is an ongoing commitment to improve the way we play, sing, or run the technical aspects of the services.

This involves:

- practising at home to improve your musicianship and/or vocal competency
- attending monthly team practices
- learning how to skilfully operate equipment we use
- being organised with your personal music files
- caring for your instruments
- being creative and courageous in trying new things to improve our worship ministry.

### **Spiritual Growth**

**Spiritual Growth** is a steady, consistent maturing of your Christian lives enabling you to be fully effective in this front-line ministry. People in worship ministry need to be aware of the spiritual opposition they face and to be extra vigilant to nurture their walk with God.

Things such as a regular devotional time, an active prayer life, membership in a Life Group, and attending spiritual growth events are all important ways to invest in our spiritual growth.



## GETTING INVOLVED

Being part of our **Worship Team** involves a serious commitment to a ministry that is vital to our church. For singers and musicians, joining the team involves an audition process and a three-month integration, including time serving as a Greeter and attending practices. For Techs, we offer on the job training and support.
